General Conditions

- Rider's age is determined by Sunday 8th October 2023
- Rider's must be current financial members of Pony Club Australia through a PCA Accredited Riding Centre or China Pony Club
- One horse per rider.
- The same horse cannot perform the dressage test more than twice on the same day.
- Pony Club Australia National Gear Rules apply to all gear used by competitor and the horse and can be found at https://ponyclubaustralia.com.au/sports/national-gear-rules/

Judging Conditions

- All tests will be judged from a video recording to ensure a level playing field
- Overall team points are accumulated from each test (4 tests in total)
- Team tests can be ridden across a combination of any of the dressage tests and can be mixed (ie Prep A and a Preliminary competitor can combine)
- Each rider in a team can ride their dressage test only once
- If a rider is eliminated in a test, Individual points will not be awarded for that test, but the rider is eligible to score points from the other test towards the individual competition and the team competition
- Points awarded at the completion of each event will be totalled to determine the Individual Champion, who will be the rider with the highest combined individual value across both tests.
- If there are equal placings for Individual Champion, the champion will be determined as follows:
 - A) The rider with the highest aggregate percentage of the two tests combined
 - B) If there is still a tie, the rider with the highest score in the .2 test
 - C) If there is still a tie, the rider with the highest score in the .1 test

Dress

- Riders are to be in neutral coloured jodphurs or approved riding pants, with short or long sleeve riding shirt, and boots and helmet as approved by the <u>National Gear Rules</u>
- White gloves are to be worn during the test

Arena

- The Arena must be 20m x 60m in size or 20x40 in size if a larger is not available
- It must be correctly positioned with all arena letters visibly clear and positioned correctly around the arena
