Lesson length: 25 mins			
Sequence	Duration	Activity	Note
Introduction Equipment Needed	5 mins	My Name is: (Coach name) My Topic is: Parts of the Horse (workbook and/or practical session) The purpose of this lesson is: learn the different parts of the horse Equipment: Pony E Certificate manual. Pencils to colour.	E certificate manual page 33
Explanation	5 mins	Why? Easier to know correct terms when describing something about your horse for example 'Crumpets fetlock is swollen' How? Identifying parts and pointing on horse or picture	
Demonstration	10 mins	Practical demonstration. Approach a quiet pony in a yard and identify the following parts: Nostril, Mane, Wither, Forelock, Knee, Fetlock, Flank, Ears, Forehead. Workbook: Complete activity on page 33 of E certificate manual.	
Feedback	5 mins	Ask a mix of open and closed questions to each rider to assess their understanding. Summarise the lesson (tell the riders what you've taught them). Positive feedback and homework suggestions. Ask if they have any questions or feedback for you. Thank the riders and dismiss them safely!	
Evaluation		Record your reflections on the lesson in your Coach journal and note any particular problems riders may have experienced.
