What is Website Builder?




Club website builder allows you to design sophisticated websites for your organisation to advertise and market your membership benefits, events and many more.

Club Website Builder will be available in your Menu.




Home page



In your website Home is where your members will first land.


You can rename the page to make it more relevant for your members

Decorate your web pages with multiple widgets to enhance your website experience




Widgets

To open the widget panel select Add Content.




Widgets

Text & Image combines both widgets giving you the functionalities of both tools.




Events and social feeds

For Instagram, you will need to generate an access token. To enable Events reach out to Support@JustGo.com




Map, Contacts and Grid

Page settings and SEO




You can select different icons for individual pages of your website or hide the navigation bar, header, or footer through settings.
