<p>Compulsory</p> <p>Compulsory for 2023, 2024 and 2025 renewals</p> <p>Completion of ASC Coaching Essentials online course (2022 version) – 2 points</p> <p>Participate in a NCAS refresher coaches' school including examiner's or coach educator workshop presented by PCA, a State Association or other approved education provider - (2 max)</p> <p>Weekend course = 6 points</p> <p>AND/OR</p> <p>Completion of webinars and online training sessions that include an assessment task, for example PCA Inclusive Coaching (2 points each)</p>	6	12
<p>Act as a Mentor Coach for a PCANCAS coaching applicant for a period of not less than 6 months</p> <p>2 points per mentee</p>	4	6
<p>Coaching other than at Pony club on a regular basis (minimum 3 times per year) eg Riding for the Disabled, private clients</p>	2	2
<p>Attend a judge's school/course designing/technical delegate course or conference run by PCA or EA</p>	4	4
